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ROAD CLOSING NOTICE


**EATONTOWN ROAD
COUNTY ROAD 70
TOWNS OF GREENVILLE & WAWAYANDA
COUNTY OF ORANGE**

The undersigned Commissioner of Public Works of the County of Orange does hereby close all that portion of County Road 70 (Eatontown Road) in the Towns of Greenville and Wawayanda, Orange County, New York. **BEGINNING** at a point approximately 1,300 feet north from the intersection of County Road 70 (Eatontown Road) and US Rte. 6 and runs **THENCE** in a northwesterly direction along said County Road 70 (Eatontown Road) approximately 400 feet (0.08 miles) for the purpose of allowing the Orange County Department of Public Works, its agents or contractors, to excavate, repair, pave and do all such work as required in connection with the "Replacement of a County Culvert" on said County Road 70 (Eatontown Road). Said closing being effective by the conspicuous posting of "Road Closed" signs on or about **September 3, 2024**.

Said County road will be closed to all through traffic for a period of approximately **twelve (12)** days in accordance with the provisions of Section 104 of the Highway Law. Appropriate traffic control devices, in accordance with the provisions of the National Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices (MUTCD), and the New York State Supplement, will be in place and detour routes will be prominently marked. In the case of inclement weather or other unforeseen problems, this period of time may be extended as needed.

Normal through traffic using this portion of County Road 70 (Eatontown Road) should use alternate routes or signed detour routing that will utilize US Rte. 6, S. Centerville Road, Burnt Corners Road, Grahamtown Road, and County Road 94 (Greenville Turnpike).

NOTE TO TOWN SUPERINTENDENTS: If the road being closed is a Town Road, the County will erect the necessary signs, barricades, etc. This does not relieve the Town Superintendent of his responsibility under Section 104 of the Highway Law to assure that such signs and barricades have been erected and maintained.

Detour Directions for CR. 70 (Eatontown Road), Towns of Greenville & Wawayanda:

Traveling East on US Rte. 6

1. Proceed beyond the intersection of US Rte. 6 and CR. 70 (Eatontown Road) for approximately 1.1 miles to the intersection with S. Centerville Road.
2. Turn left onto S. Centerville Road and proceed northerly for approximately 1.5 miles to the intersection of S. Centerville Road, Mullock Road, and Burnt Corners Road.
3. Continue straight (north) onto Burnt Corners Road for approximately 0.6 miles to the intersection with Grahamtown Road.
4. Turn left onto Grahamtown Road and proceed west for approximately 0.6 miles to the intersection with CR. 94 (Greenville Turnpike).
5. Turn left onto CR. 94 (Greenville Turnpike) and proceed southwest for approximately 1.8 miles to CR. 70 (Eatontown Road).

(End of Detour)

Traveling West of U.S. Rte. 6

1. At the intersection of US Rte. 6 and S. Centerville Road, turn right onto S. Centerville Road and proceed northerly for approximately 1.5 miles to the intersection of S. Centerville Road, Mullock Road, and Burnt Corners Road.
2. Continue straight (north) onto Burnt Corners Road for approximately 0.6 miles to the intersection with Grahamtown Road.
3. Turn left onto Grahamtown Road and proceed west for approximately 0.6 miles to the intersection with CR. 94 (Greenville Turnpike).
4. Turn left onto CR. 94 (Greenville Turnpike) and proceed southwest for approximately 1.8 miles to CR. 70 (Eatontown Road).

(End of Detour)

Traveling South on Eatontown Road

1. At the intersection of Eatontown Road and CR 94 (Greenville Turnpike), turn left onto CR 94 (Greenville Turnpike) and continue northeasterly for approximately 1.8 miles to the intersection with Grahamtown Road.
2. Turn right onto Grahamtown Road and proceed easterly approximately 0.6 miles to the intersection with Burnt Corners Road.
3. Turn right onto Burnt Corners Road and proceed south for approximately 0.6 miles to the intersection of S. Centerville Road, Mullock Road, and Burnt Corners Road.
4. Continue straight (south) onto S. Centerville Road and proceed 1.5 miles to the intersection of S. Centerville Road and US Rte. 6.
5. Turn right onto US Rte. 6 and proceed westerly for approximately 1.1 miles to CR. 70 (Eatontown Road).
