Highway News:

- Drainage project at Stapleton Court was completed.
- Drainage project at Ridgebury Lake Acres was also completed.
- Continue to upgrade drainage at Robinn Meadows.
- Tom continues to respond to concerns brought forward by residents.
- Paving is on track for the end of August/beginning of September.
- Removed and graded dirt to correct the site distance problem on Turtle Bay Road.
- Met with the town engineer, the City of Middletown and Southgate regarding their entrance on Uhlig Road.
- Continued mowing along roads.

Shannen Park:

- The Senior Center was rented once this month.
- The pavilions have been busy on the weekends.
- The dog park at Shannen Park has been completed and is open for business.
- Now that we have been renting out the Senior Center for about a year, Barbara met with the Pacers to discuss any concerns or questions they may have about how the procedure is going.
