Highway News:

- Several roads had shoulders that were repaired including Vetoski, Ridgebury Hill, Turtle Bay and Post Roads.

- Plows were put on the trucks in preparation for winter plowing.
- The crew successfully completed State required classes in Hazardous Materials training and Workplace Violence training.

- Work on the baseball fence was started at the Ryerson Road Park.
