

**TOWN OF WAWAYANDA
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
PROPOSED LOCAL LAW**

PUBLIC NOTICE is hereby given that there has been introduced before the Town Board of the Town of Wawayanda, New York, on April 5, 2018, a proposed local law entitled **“A LOCAL TO AMEND CHAPTER 180-23 VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC / STOP INTERSECTIONS OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF WAWAYANDA.”**

The purpose of this local law is to amend Chapter 180, Section 180-23 of the Code of the Town of Wawayanda to add stop signs on Kirbytown Road at the intersection with Uhlig Road. Residents of Kirbytown Road have observed an increasing amount of vehicular traffic that proceeds at speeds threatening the health and safety of the residents on that road, particularly children.

A complete copy of the proposed Local Law is available for inspection at the Town Clerk’s Office.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the Municipal Home Rule Law, and Section 29-1 of the Code of the Town of Wawayanda, the Town Board of the Town of Wawayanda, New York, will hold a public hearing on the aforesaid proposed Local Law at the Town Hall, 80 Ridgebury Hill Road, Slate Hill, New York on Thursday August 2, 2018, at 7:00 P.M., or soon thereafter, at which time all persons interested therein shall be heard.

The Town of Wawayanda will make every effort to assure that the hearing is accessible to persons with disabilities. Anyone requiring special assistance and/or reasonable accommodations should contact the Town Clerk.
